The American Red Cross Babysitter's Training program is designed to provide youth who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills; learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe and help children behave; and get certified in Pediatric First Aid and CPR. This training is designed for youths ages 11 to 15, but we will allow ages 10-16.
