**VACANT POSITION**  
Sewer Camera Truck Operator  
Water & Sewer Department

**Job Purpose:** To inspect the cleaning of sewer lines via camera use and to create and maintain mapping of the City's sewer system.

- Directs a work crew in cleaning and camera inspection of sanitary sewer lines and storm sewer lines.
- Reviews work orders to repair or evaluate sewer problems.
- Receives, prepares, reviews and forwards reports and records such as tap orders, sewer maps, work orders, etc.
- Operates cameras to photograph the inside of sewer lines to conduct inspections and determines need for repairs.
- Assists work crews with difficult situations.
- Assists in water and sewer line locating and leak detection using equipment and instrumentation.
- Operates video camera, pipe locator, computer, leak detection equipment, etc.
- Services and makes minor repair to equipment.
- Develops and maintains the City sewer maps.
- Inspects construction of new sewers and manholes.
- Performs exceptional service to internal and external customers.

**Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**

- Ability to work with the public.
- Ability to operate equipment such as video equipment, pipe locator, drafting tools and instruments, computer, leak detection equipment, etc.

**Minimum Qualifications:** High School Diploma or equivalent with 2-3 years experience in water and sewer infrastructure work using computer knowledge preferred or any combination of education, training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities. Must possess a valid S.C. driver's license.
